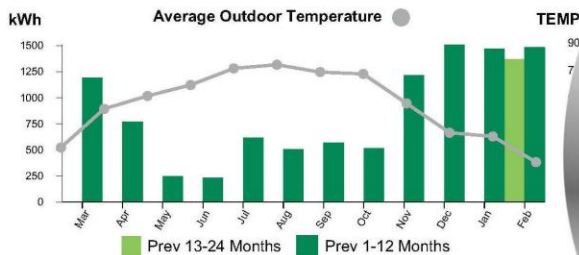

Energy Usage Comparison



1. POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) is a variable energy rate which can fluctuate from month to month based on wholesale power costs. In other words, when the cost of power purchased by Boone Electric Cooperative exceeds the amount presently included in our base rates, the PCA adjusts the price of electricity to make up the difference on an as-needed basis. This helps keep base electric rates stable and appears as the PCA line item. Under the new rate structure effective with your May bill, the PCA line item will revert to zero.

2. ELECTRIC SERVICE

The actual cost of electricity used (measured in kilowatt-hours, or kWh) by the member at their meter based on rates that became effective reflecting April 2026 usage.

3. SERVICE AVAILABILITY

The service availability charge is a flat fee per meter which helps cover the fixed costs of operating Boone Electric's distribution infrastructure such as poles, wire, transformers and other equipment. Effective with your May bill, the service availability charge is \$39.25

* OPERATION ROUND UP

The Operation Round Up is a line item appearing as "Round Up" only on bills for those members who participate in Operation Round Up.

Boone Electric Cooperative members may choose to round up their monthly electric bill to the next highest dollar amount, with the difference in change going to the Boone Electric Community Trust. Round Up participants donate an average of \$6 per year. These funds, combined with unclaimed capital credits and donations, are cumulatively awarded to local nonprofit and public entities by the BEC Trust.
